COVID-19.....What MASC is doing to protect you!

How can I contract COVID-19?

- COVID-19 can be spread through



- Person to person contact if the person either has the virus or is carrying the virus on their hands or clothing.
- Viral droplets from a sneeze or cough from the nose or mouth which are spread when a person with COVID-19 coughs, sneezes or exhales.
- Contaminated surfaces (depending on the type of surface, it can be contaminated anywhere from 3 to 72 hours)
- Breathing in droplets from a person with COVID-19 who coughs out or exhales droplets.

What are the best practices to avoid contracting COVID-19?

- Wash your hands after touching any surfaces in a public place.
- Avoid touching your face, especially nose, eyes and mouth.
- Stay at least 6 feet away from people who are not wearing masks.



What our facility is doing to protect YOU.

- Employees will be washing hands after each patient interaction or touching a public surface to keep you safe.
- Disinfecting surfaces after each patient including waiting area and recovery room with germicidal wipes.
- All employees will be wearing masks in close contact.
- Employees will be staying home if sick.
